Preston's College Bursary

Preston's College are able to offer learners access to a number of bursary funds, aimed at supporting individuals with specific financial difficulties that may otherwise prevent access to learning. Eligibility for funding is dependent upon household income, and recent evidence of this must be submitted at the time you complete your bursary application. Bursary applications can be made online and you do not need to wait until your course begins.

Applications are open now for September 2020 and you will need your learner ID number to apply.

SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disability Support) Team

Preston's College adopts an inclusive approach to learning, offering high quality teaching to all, which takes into account individual requirements. Reasonable adjustments are embedded within the classroom, to ensure that those learners with an identified need can fully access the curriculum and the associated assessment processes.

It is recognised that some learners may also need additional support and this will be provided by the Curriculum and Learner Support Team. The focus of support is to remove barriers to learning and develop strategies. Naturally, support needs differ from individual to individual but may include the provision of exam access arrangements, assistive technology, learning support coaches/assistants and communication support workers.

FACILITIES AT PRESTON'S COLLEGE

At Preston's College, we have a range of outstanding facilities across all of our courses, including an industry standard Construction Centre, 100 seater theatre and a purpose built i-STEM Centre – home to an array of course specific facilities, including engineering workshops and a subsonic wind tunnel.

Food Outlets

The Preston's College campus offers an array of food and drink choices, including the Food Court - the main destination for all food and drink requirements! Home to a full refectory, serving subsidised hot meals and freshly prepared sandwiches and salads, Snack Attack - a quick, food-to-go option serving healthy choices including jacket potatoes, soup and wraps and the second floor, Balcony Bar offering a more relaxed place to enjoy a panini or pizza. Learning Zone and Library

The Learning Zone, housed over two floors, provides high quality support for learning outside of the classroom and a variety of individual and group study spaces.

Our learning zone team are always on hand to help you access the resources, services and support needed to develop your own independent study and research skills. The team offer a huge range of workshops on key topics including developing Harvard referencing, assignment writing and critical analysis.

In the Learning Zone, you will also find Nineteen+ facilities; spaces reserved exclusively for our adult learners that provide seating, quick response computers for study and areas where adult learners can eat and drink, whilst studying.

The Learning Zone also offers self-issue kiosks for the borrowing and return of books, with eBooks and e-journals offered on a 24/7 access basis. The area is also home to over 90 PCs, bookable group work rooms and individual study spaces.

Learner Parking

Public Transport

Preston train station is a short, 10 minute walk from the city's bus station and a range of bus services including the 4C, 19A (Royal Preston Hospital), 23 (Sherwood Asda) and the Preston Orbital (88A and 88C) bus routes all serve the College, from the main bus station. There are numerous other bus routes to the College from the surrounding areas, with many learners travelling to us from Chorley, Lancaster and Blackpool.
