- > Basic entry qualification that provides solid grounding for students with no previous bookkeeping knowledge or experience
- > 10 week course
- > Studied on a part-time basis
- > Classroom based
- > Assessment involves a final computer based assessment under exam conditions



UNITS OF STUDY AND ASSESSMENT METHODS

As part of the course you will study a range of units including:

- Understand the role of the bookkeeper
- Understand financial transactions
- Process customer and supplier transactions
- Process receipts and payments
- > This course is based on learning and applying theory within a set exam.

 Knowledge and skills are tested via a computer based assessment, run entirely on PCs or laptops.
- > To achieve competency, each exam requires a 70% pass rate.



PROGRESSION OPPORTUNITIES

This course is a good introduction for those with an interest in bookkeeping, looking to gain the basics in accounting, accounting terminology and some accounting functions. The course provides opportunities, upon successful completion, to progress onto the AAT Level 2 Foundation Certificate in Accounting.
