WELCOME

At the Musical Theatre Training Academy (MTTA), we create a vibrant and energetic environment in which you can explore, experiment and develop in the disciplines needed within the Musical Theatre industry. Led by tutors with professional industry experience, this programme is designed to prepare young performers for the next steps in this highly competitive profession.

MTTA is based at Preston College in the Visual & Performing Arts building which is equipped with industry standard facilities including a versatile 100 seater theatre, rehearsal studios and dance studios with sprung harlequin flooring. We also have the Amphitheatre – our unique outdoor performance space. In addition to the performance facilities, the College has many other resources available, such as an onsite gym, fantastic library services and multiple food outlets including a Starbucks café.

PURPOSE

At MTTA our ethos is to help and guide each performer to achieve their potential and their highest learning grades. We aim to instill our performers with a willingness for continuous improvement through personal reflection, the exploration of creative thought processes, and a desire to seek out and undertake new challenges to extend their capabilities.

Overall, our aim is to educate each performer in an aspirational atmosphere to discover their strengths and to support them in their progression, whether that is university, drama school, or independent training.

ACCREDITATION

Our courses are accredited by the University of the Arts London (UAL) – a top two world ranking university. Upon completion of one of our programmes, graduates will achieve either a Level 2 Diploma or a Level 3 Extended Diploma in Performing and Production Arts.

The Level 3 Extended Diploma carries the same UCAS points as three A-Levels or a Level 3 BTEC Extended Diploma, this along with the skills you develop on the programme supports your progression to the best training and education options after college.









MUSICAL THEATRE DISCIPLINES

UAL LEVEL 3 EXTENDED DIPLOMA IN PERFORMING & PRODUCTION ARTS

The Level 3 Programme will develop your skills in the disciplines of musical theatre which are acting, singing and dancing. Proficiency in these three disciplines is essential for a successful career in the musical theatre industry. Masters of these disciplines are sometimes referred to as 'triple threats' as these performers are more adaptable and can take on a wider variety of roles.

During the two year programme you will expand your technical and theoretical understanding and practical ability in each discipline and apply this in performance. On successful completion of the programme you will achieve an industry recognised qualification and the skills needed to be a strong candidate for universities and drama schools.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The programme focusses on the three main disciplines of musical theatre:

ACTING

SINGING

DANCING

Each week you will attend two classes per discipline. One of which will be a technique-based session that focusses on overall skills development of the subject. The other will be project-based, where you will be encouraged to put your skills into practice through collaboration with other performers to deliver a practical project, which might culminate in a final performance. The programme progresses through different phases to encourage autonomy in each discipline.



YEAR 1

Phase 1 – Skills Development

During this phase you will go back to basics and build upon your existing strengths, instilling the correct techniques and discipline needed for the rest of the programme.

Phase 2 - Production process

Building on your skills from Phase 1 you will now explore the different processes in the creation of a performance from both a performance and a production perspective.

Phase 3 – Professional Practice

At the end of year one, you will be given the opportunity to experience every stage of a full production process from auditioning and rehearsals to the final performance.

YEAR 2

Phase 1 - Advanced Skills Development

Following on from year one, you will focus on more advanced skills needed in each discipline and take a more autonomous role within each class. You are expected to be able to justify decisions and apply the different theories into your own practice, building your own personal repertoire to take forward to auditions and showcases.

Phase 2 – Professional Industry Awareness

During this phase you will be free to explore contemporary issues facing the Musical Theatre industry and how these issues affect the creation and production of shows.

Phase 3 – Professional Practice & Final Major Project

Just like in year one, it is now time to put everything into practice. You will go through a full production process, however this time; you will select your own area of focus for a research project that will accompany your rehearsal and performance process.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For entry at Level 3 you are required to have five GCSE grades at 4 or above, one of which must be Maths or English Language. If you have studied our Level 2 programme and wish to progress to Level 3, you must have at least a Merit as your final grade. All new entrants will be subject to an audition before being offered a place.

AUDITIONS

You will be required to attend an audition which consists of:

- > A dance workshop
- Acting monologue audition selected by MTTA
- Individual singing audition selected by the individual

This process is required for us to assess your ability for the programme.



PROGRESSION ROUTES

Our Level 3 Musical Theatre programme is ideal preparation for progression to drama school or university for both performance and non-performance roles.

We have a strong history of our learners progressing to their top choices of well-respected institutions, such as:

We annually visit London and New York to experience shows and professional workshops with trips to local theatres, drama schools and events also offered throughout the year.

WORKSHOPS

We regularly invite current industry professionals to provide workshops and Q&A sessions with our learners, providing you with the opportunity to receive training and advice from experts in their field. Previous workshops and Q&A's have included current West End and UK Tour performers, national casting directors, choreographers for Strictly Come Dancing, radio and TV scriptwriters and the National Youth Theatre.

PREPARATION FOR PERFORMANCE TRAINING

JAL LEVEL 2 DIPLOMA IN PERFORMING & PRODUCTION ARTS

The purpose of this course is to train you in techniques and skills which will enhance your overall ability levels. You will develop a strong foundation of skills in all three major performance disciplines of Acting, Singing and Dancing. At the end of the course you will can to progress to the Level 3 programme of Acting for Stage & Screen, or onto the Level 3 Musical Theatre programme. Your progression to your chosen course will depend on the achievement of the Level 2 qualification, your attendance and punctuality and on fulfilling the entry requirements of the Level 3 programme. Your Student Manager will discuss your progression options with you.

COURSE STRUCTURE

THEATRE

Our 100 seater theatre is a strong performance space which we have utilised in the traditional end-on style, but also in the round and traverse for various productions.

AMPHITHEATRE

The Amphitheatre at MTTA is a truly unique outdoor performance space. Built in the 1980s, the space has recently been renovated and used to host our end of year performance.

REHEARSAL STUDIO

We have three main rehearsal rooms, which are used for workshops, preparation and rehearsals. Performance spaces all have mirrors available so learners can scrutinise every element of their performance.

DANCE STUDIOS

There are seven dance and performance studios, five of which have sprung harlequin flooring, air conditioning and full-length mirrors.



ATA ACTOR TRAINING ACADEMY

You will spend one full term studying acting in a number of contexts, covering three of the technical pillars taught on the Level 3 ATA course: Stage Acting, Movement and Voice. You will apply these techniques to scripts and other performance material in rehearsal settings, logging your progress within written portfolios.

MTTA MUSICAL THEATRE TRAINING ACADEMY

You will spend one full term studying the three technical disciplines taught on the Level 3 MTTA course: Singing, Acting and Dance. You will apply these techniques to a small Musical Theatre practical project, logging your progress within written portfolios.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You must have four GCSE Grades at 3 or above. You will complete an induction period to assess your suitability for this level and must go through the Level 3 audition process.

PROGRESSION & PERFORMANCE

In your final term, you will take part in a full production process: from audition to rehearsal, through to a final performance. You will have the opportunity to research and audition for your preferred performance project (ATA or MTTA). You will also complete a personal research project that supports your rehearsal process.
